(*Label Glows in Dark*)

Description:

The strength of the Priorato wine region is in the wine and in the grape, the Garnacha, showing a piece of this land, so characteristic of its terroir.

Tasting Notes:

Intense cherry color with violet highlights show the youth of this wine. In the nose, it shows complex fruity aromas combined with notes of fresh jam. Minerally, and fresh in the mouth, with a sweet fruit bouquet.
