The Invisible Man

Description

This wine is a different way of experiencing Tempranillo in Rioja. In Rioja Alta, the vineyards are furthest North and very close to a village named Cuzcurrita de Rio Tiron, where the climate is influenced by the Atlantic Ocean. With three different types of soils in our vineyards: claystone, stony and Iron-clayish, we have elaborated a new world style wine from the heart of the old world wines kingdom.

Tasting Notes

Deep cherry color with a violet rim showing its youth. Good aromatic intensity of very ripe red-berry fruits, with hints of fine pastries well integrated with the nuances of the French barrels. Structured with soft, sweet tannins, and a general hint of toasted wood, this discreet and friendly wine accompanies all of these aromatic and taste sensations. Intense in the mouth, and long in the finish, you can taste the quality.
